Capitol Hill School READ-A-THON (April 9-15, 2018)

Dear Capitol Hill Families,

This year, our school is participating in a Read-a-Thon to support the school's literacy initiatives during Literacy week. Funds raised will go directly to purchase new books for our school.

Here's how it works

- <u>Step 1:</u> Please read the rules and expectations of the Read-A-Thon and have your child set a reading goal (number of minutes per day for 7 days).
- <u>Step 2:</u> Have your child ask people to sponsor them by pledging a flat rate for when the child reaches their goal (minutes). Remind your child that relatives, neighbors, friends and even often-frequented businesses make GREAT sponsors!
- <u>Step 3:</u> April 9th April 15th (one week reading challenge) your child will read and record their minutes daily using the Minutes Recording Sheet (on the back of the rules). Please sign your child's recording chart when completed.
- <u>Step 4:</u> April 16th-18th your child will tally up their minutes and begin collecting their pledge money from the sponsors.
- <u>Step 5:</u> Bring the collected money and completed recording sheet to the classroom teacher no later than **Thursday**, **April 19**th.

Capitol Hill Read-A-Thon Rules & Expectations

- Start reading and recording your minutes on Monday, April 9th.
- Use your Minute Recording Sheet to keep track of how many minutes you read each day.

Here's what counts toward your minutes	These DO NOT count during the event		
 ✓ Reading before and after school ✓ Being read to by others ✓ Reading aloud to others ✓ Reading anything, in any language 	 Minutes read before the official start of the read-a-thon Reading during class time 		

- No guessing minutes. Please look at the clock or use a timer or stopwatch to clock your minutes.
- Please remember that CHARACTER COUNTS be honest with your minutes so that it will be fair and fun for everyone. Remember that your parents will need to initial your minutes on the Minute Recording Sheet.
- The last day to read for the READ-A-THON is Sunday April 15th

Make sure that you return your Minute Recording Sheet /Sponsorship Form, and your collected money in an envelope to school by April 19th.

Prize Draw:

- All students who turn in Read-a-thon sheet will be entered into a draw for fabulous prizes
- School Wide reading minutes (55,000 minutes) is met, extra recess for all students
