Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

Welcome back and I hope that you have all enjoyed a fabulous and restful holidays. Our second term promises to be one filled with many activities for our students to be involved in throughout the term. Our Grade 6 and 7 students will be taking part in a Public Speaking competition and our Primary students will be involved in the Primary Days of Music. Our next Professional Day will be on Friday, February 22nd. Our staff will be attending workshops at Burnaby North Secondary and Cariboo Hill Secondary. School will not be in session for students that day.

With the cold and wet conditions that we have been experiencing since late in November, I would like to remind all of us to ensure that our students dress appropriately as they will be going outside for recess and lunch, unless the weather conditions become too extreme or unsafe. We also are cautioning all pedestrians and drivers around the school, that with these slippery conditions to be very careful as vehicles do not have the same stopping abilities as in normal weather conditions. I was outside recently one morning on Holdom Avenue to observe how the and parking situation looks at the start of each day as we have been getting a number of parents coming to the office with concerns of drivers making unsafe driving decisions as they drive children to school and pickup their children at the end of the day. I saw most parents being very mindful of the and parking regulations, however I did speak with a few parents about parking too close to the Hastings/Holdom Ave. intersection (on the east side of Holdom Ave). We have a fabulous crossing guard who assists our students and their families to use the intersection at Hastings and Holdom. Parking regulations require that no vehicles are parked (even for drop off) close to the intersection. We ask that you please follow these regulations to ensure safety for all. I also observed a few parents making a Uturn on Holdom Ave. There is clear signage indicating that this is not to be done, once again for reasons of safety. I also saw a few students being let out of cars on the west side of Holdom Ave. and then the students walked across the street mid-block (Jaywalking). Once again for reasons of safety we ask that parents and children be reminded that this is an unsafe practice. Please use the cross walks at either Holdom/Hastings or Holdom/Pandora. We are all concerned for our Capitol Hill community and ask you all to be extra vigilant whenever you drive in and around our school. On a note, we have been developing a Parking/Traffic survey with a group of our parents that will be coming out in the next month, so that we can get your input and feedback on the important matters of traffic and parking at Capitol Hill. Thank you to everyone for your attention to this important matter.
