

Grade 6/7 MACC CLASS SUPPLY LIST – CAPITOL HILL

In our MACC 6/7 class, our supply list is different from the intermediate grades at Capitol Hill. This is a preliminary list; more items may be added in September or during the school year. Most of the “specialty” items are available at Staples.

In order for our classroom to function efficiently, it is important that you have all of your supplies and that they arrive during the first days of school.

If the purchasing of these supplies presents a financial hardship for your family, please speak with Mr. Gaitens at the beginning of the school year.

- 1 two-pack black Flair felt-tip pens
- 1 two-pack or four-pack Uni-ball “Vision” roller pens, 0.7mm
- 2 black fine-tipped sharpie markers
- 2 black ultra-fine-tipped sharpie markers
- 2 packages of pencils (at least 10 per package)
- 2 highlighters (at least 1 yellow)
- 1 package of colored pencil crayons (we will use these **a lot**, so the more colors the better!)
- 1 pair of durable, sharp, adult scissors (not student, blunted scissors)
- 1 wood, clear plastic, or metal ruler (30 cm) – **no bendable rulers, please—these become distractions**
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 small bottle of tacky glue (not white glue)
- 1 set of multi-coloured, **chisel-tipped**, dry erase whiteboard markers, with eraser (spray optional)
- 1 packet (100 pages) lined paper

- 2 standard 9- $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ " composition notebooks, black or black and white marbled cover, 200 pages, preferably with stitch-binding, such as Hilroy (Staples item #43073)
- 1 solid BLACK 3-ring, plastic binder, 1.5" **Grade 7s: note size change**
- 1 solid RED 3-ring, plastic binder, 1"
- 2 packages of 8 colored dividers each for 3-ring binders
- 1 pencil sharpener with storage for shavings
- 3 erasers (white vinyl preferred)
- 1 math set (at least with protractor and compass)
- 1 USB Memory Stick (1GB)
- 1 standard calculator
- One bottle or roll of white-out
- pencil case for storage of smaller personal items
- an accordion file folder (or other file folder with dividers for organization) for homework, for your backpack
- earbuds or headphones

Please do not get a zipper binder.
