CLASS PLACEMENT

We are beginning the process of forming the classes for September. This process is a very complex one, as it requires the consideration of many variables. Some of the key considerations include Ministry designations, support needed, leadership skills, academic achievement, social-emotional and behavior profiles. We also look at social groupings, class dynamics, combined class variations and curricular demands. Our students' well-being and academic success is at the center of all decision-making and our goal is to have balanced classes. This process starts in June of each year and continues in the first week of September. The classroom teachers, in consultation with the learning support teachers, counselor, ELL teachers, head teacher, and principal work as a team to put classes together.

Throughout the year, teachers become increasingly aware of your child's learning profile, both through daily interactions and discussions with you. However, if there is any additional information that you wish us to consider, please provide it using our online class placement form. If you have more than one child that attends Capitol Hill that you would like to provide input for, please submit a separate form for each child. The form will be available online until May 23rd.

Please be aware that due to student numbers in each grade, it is very likely that most of our classes will be combined grades, and we will not be able to accommodate requests for single grade classes. Information on combined grade classes can be found here. Additionally, we are unable to accommodate requests for specific teachers or for grade/class combinations.



We continue to have many students arriving late to school in the mornings and it causes us some concern. Our school bell rings at 8:50 am each morning.

Arriving on time allows students to feel prepared and ready for the day. Arriving late means that your child is likely missing important notices and introductions to the school day. Please ensure your child arrives promptly for the day.
